## Free Home Repairs

Rebuilding Together is the nation's leading nonprofit working to preserve affordable homeownership and revitalize communities. Our network of more than 200 affiliates provides free rehabilitation and critical repairs to the homes of low-income Americans.

## What we do

Rebuilding Together serves rural Caroline County and works to insure a safe and healthy home for every person. In our first sixteen months we have completed over two dozen jobs for the elderly, disabled, veterans or families with children; ten of these have been wheelchair ramps; others have included repairing ceilings and floors, improving insulation, installing a handicap accessible bathroom shower. Our mode of operation is a rolling repair program, taking applications as they come, for those that qualify doing what we can, and moving on.

## Who we help

As the economic pressure on low-income families grows, more and more families are placed in the position of choosing between vital necessities and essential home repairs and modifications.
